NEW: Daily Health Checklist Update

RVS continues to require all students, staff, and visitors to use the <u>Alberta Daily Health Checklist</u> (click on the link to view) prior to coming to school. Please note that recent and significant changes have been made by Alberta Health Services to this document. Most notably: students who are not fully immunized and are a household contact with a positive case of COVID-19 should remain home for 14 days from the last day of exposure and monitor for symptoms. Parents/Guardians play an essential role as they support actions in the home (such as keeping children/students home when sick and accessing testing if symptoms develop) that ultimately keep other children, students, and staff safe.

NEW: Fireside School Nutrition Program

Due to Covid restrictions, we have changed how students access our School Nutrition Program this year, so we wanted to share this information with our families.

For those students who may have forgotten their lunch or snacks or for those who need school to supply a lunch (no questions asked), they will be able to access a brown bag lunch. These lunches will be available through Ms. Clark and Ms. Abrahams.

Healthy snacks and fruit will be available in the main office, the Roost, Learning Support classrooms, and CDA offices.

Student Absences

If a student is going to be away for any reason, please let the office know either through an email or by calling the school. You are also encouraged to let the classroom teacher know, of course. Thank you for your help with this.

Parents' Drop Off and Pick Up

Parents who come to either pick-up or drop off their children are asked to follow all traffic regulations. Students can be dropped off in the "Kiss & Go" lane in front of the school or down any neighboring streets. The bus lanes on the north side of the building must remain clear. As well, we continue to ask that families do not park in the staff parking lot (northwest corner behind the building). In addition to being a safety concern, busses may need to block the entrance of this lot when they park.

Appointments

There may be times when you need to pick up your child during instructional times. Parents or guardians will need to come into the building and sign their children out. We ask that you also notify the student's homeroom teacher in advance to let them know your child will be leaving.

Item Drop Off

Forgotten lunches? Shoes? Homework? On occasion, parents need to drop off items for their child during the school day. Like last year, we will have a cart at the front entrance where you can leave items that are clearly marked with the child's first and last name. We will ensure they are delivered to the child as soon as we are able to do so.

Visitors and Volunteers

At Fireside School, we love our volunteers and are excited to welcome them back. Our plan is to take a cautious approach with volunteers as we follow the Rocky View Schools' School Operation Plan. Please keep an "eye out" in the next month for more information on how and where we can have our amazing volunteers supporting the learning of students.

Lunch

Students staying at school will eat lunch in their classrooms, while those who choose to go home for lunch are permitted to do so. If your child will be going home for lunch each day, please contact the homeroom teacher so we are aware of who is leaving. **Students who are leaving must make the commitment to leave each day and may not pick and choose when to stay and when to go**.

Fireside School is a closed campus; therefore, students may not leave the premises unless we have confirmation from home, including at lunch. Reminder: lunch time this year is now from 11:35 am to 12:15 pm.
