2. **Rocky view School Division Update** – Fiona Gilbert – School Board Chair and Trustee
 - Grown by 250 kids for Rocky view. 6/9 schools in town are close to 100% capacity. Asking for modulars for Fireside school. Airdrie and Chestermere in need as well for modular. Balancing schools, and student spaces, looking for community engagement, end of April – in Airdrie. Coming to Cochrane, meeting about student spaces in the next year or so. Fiona serving for board chair again for coming year.
 - Strategic plan – student learning, connecting with community, workforce – report is located on website for literacy and numeracy.
 - Joint board meeting is October 26th – chair and principal in attendance. Rockyview staff will do presentation on PBIS. School council presentation available from last week – recording also available online.

 - Enrollment – Sept 30th numbers used as enrollment for the year, 896 kids enrolled. 34 classrooms. (Last year, 824 students last year and 34 classrooms). Ks & 1s – lower enrollment. But grades 2/3/4 higher enrollment. (Homeschool?)

 - Swim lessons for grade 3 in September and grade 2 in spring.
 - Equine Therapy – small number of kids get to go work with horse at Spirit Winds (dress horses, care for them) For kids who are struggling, for 8 to 10 kids each year. They get grants and apply it to school for use for free.

- School Clubs are beginning – Mondays Boost Club, Tuesdays Leadership Class, Wednesdays Dungeons and Dragons, Thursdays Art Club, Fridays Chess Club, and more clubs available. Intermural starting up again. Battle of the Books starting soon.
- School Education Plan – Due next week.
 - 3 Major Goals: Advancing students literacy and numeracy skills, increasing students' appreciation and understanding on cultural diversity, creating inclusive, engaging, healthy learning opportunities for all students (PBIS).
