Elections Canada Positions for Fireside Polling Station

On Monday, April 28th, Canada goes to the polls to elect a new government. Fireside School will be one of the polling stations for the election that day. Parents and other interested parties can apply to work on Election Day at the school. Below, you will find information on how you can apply to work at the polling stations on Election Day and to ensure you work here at Fireside.

How to apply (from Elections Canada):

- 1. Go to elections.ca
- 2. Click on the **Jobs** tab located at the top of the page
- 3. Click on Poll Worker Positions
- 4. Select from one of the four available positions. Then click Apply Now.
- 5. Enter your postal code to direct the application to our offices (you must reside in our electoral district in order to work at one of the schools).
- 6. Click Apply Now again at the bottom of the page.
- 7. Complete the application, filling in all fields and the click Submit at the bottom.
- 8. If you receive a call from our recruiting department please let the agent know that you would like to work at your child's school and state the name of the school.
- 9. Alternatively, after you have completed the application online you can contact the recruiting department at **403.796.5604** to ensure that you are assigned to your child's school.

All interested parties *must* apply online first. Parents can then wait for a call from recruiting or can call us at 403-796-5604 to ensure they are placed at the correct school.

Parents can apply for any position but many will likely be interested in the role of Information Officer. This position is responsible for monitoring the polling place and guiding electors' foot traffic on Election Day.

All positions are paid. Parents will also be compensated for their mandatory training. Training will be available at our office in Cochrane. Details will be provided upon application.

Proposed Changes for 2025-26 School Fees

Each year, school administration assesses school fees to determine whether they need to be adjusted to meet costs for the coming year. Rocky View Schools mandates that program fees cannot be increased beyond \$10 or 5% of the current fee, whichever is greater. Below is a summary of proposed (pending board approval) fees for the 2025-26 school year. Fee increases this year are largely due to price increases for supplies and our service partners. If you have questions about these fees or their proposed changes, please contact the school.

Reminder: K to 3 Spring Concert – Go Fish!


Hold your breath for Fireside Schools next musical production, Go Fish!





