

Updated: Election Day Door Changes

On Monday April 28th, the gym at Fireside School will be acting as a polling station for the Federal Election. This will impact our normal operating procedures for the day. Please see below for a summary of the changes regarding students entering and exiting the building, if your child's class is not on the list below, they are to use their normal entrance and exit. We will have additional staff outside to help students and parents.

- Kindergarten: Enter and exit through the north doors, adjacent to the bus layaway (Fireside Way) across from Mr. Shaun's room. Please note it will be more busy and crowded with the number of students coming in through those doors, and there is limited space compared to the front of the building.
- Students in Mrs. Hanson's and Ms. Simpson's classes: Enter and exit through the north doors, adjacent to the bus layaway (Fireside Way) across from Mr. Shaun's room.
- Grade 1 Bussing Students: Enter through the doors adjacent the "Kiss and Go." These are the doors that open into the portables that were installed in November.
- Grade 6 Students: Enter and exit through the compound doors.

We kindly ask for your patience and understanding as we navigate the Federal Elections taking place at Fireside.


