PowerSchool Updates Needed

We want to take the time to remind families to go into your PowerSchool Portal and ensure all forms and information are updated. Please use the link to RVS PowerSchool if you need support with accessing your account.

Annual Authorizations and Re-enrolment Verification forms are due by September 8th.

 Annual Authorization and Re-enrolment verification forms have been assigned in SchoolEngage. To access School Engage, log in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal, expand the menu on the left hand side, and at the bottom of the Navigation menu along the left size, select School Engage. It will say you have incomplete forms. When switching to subsequent children, you may have to select Exit to Main PS Site to get back to that home screen.

Staggered Bus Departure

As was done in previous years, we will continue to load bus students in two waves at the end of the day.

- The first wave of buses include numbers 14, 15, 26,172, 174, & 195 which will load immediately after school. These buses will depart at 2:30 pm.
- The second wave of buses are numbers 221, 227, 258, & 283. These buses pull in after the first wave has departed. We ask that students waiting for second round busses remain on the grassy areas near the bus lane, until their bus arrives.

This year any students riding the BGC bus will meet in the learning commons and check in with Mrs. Erika. She will walk students to the BGC bus.




Terry Fox Run
