This playground will be for anyone to enjoy, not just the children of Fireside School. We expect to see multigenerational play, with Cochrane's youngest to oldest members of active families enjoying the play opportunities side by side.

We want you to be a part of this new standard for inclusivity and play design. This playground will be a point of pride for the community, both as a meeting place for families, but also as an important piece of the inclusivity conversation, and moving that incredible conversation forward.

MEET JACKI AND MALIC

Malic was diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy at birth and relies on mobility devices.

Ever since the founding of Friends of Fireside Jacki has been a strong fighter and advocate of building an inclusive playground.

After all, you would like your kids to be able to play without boundaries too, right? As a family we avoid trips to the playground as Cochrane does not yet have any that provide accessibility and inclusivity, and that hurts me. Malic believes that he can do anything his sisters can do, but when he attempts to do so his little body doesn't give him the satisfaction. He uses mobility devices to get around and thankfully these devices have allowed him to be eye to eye with his peers, to attempt to run alongside his friends during gym class and to give him a sense of independence he wouldn't have otherwise.

We are so excited at the prospect of a playground where we can all play together, where I have to run after him and where I can see him enjoy it as much as any other kid. My hope is that he grows up in a different world than I did. One where his abilities are not considered disabilities.
