NEW: Cochrane Family Resource Network Program

The Cochrane Family Resource Network with the Town of Cochrane is offering a free 6-week program called Triple P Fear-Less, which starts Monday, September 19 from 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm. This program supports parents to help children (ages 6-14) manage their anxiety.

For those who are not familiar with Triple P, it is an evidence-based positive parenting program out of Australia and one the Government of Alberta funds for all Resource Networks. NEW: International Literacy Day

Thursday, September 8th was International Literacy Day. If you were at our Open House, you hopefully picked up some reading discussion tips and took a look at our "Guess Who's Reading?" wall down by our Literacy Centre. Love of Reading is a foundational cornerstone of Fireside School and we look forward to sharing reading tips with you in future *Fireside Focus* newsletters.

Here are a few initial ways to discuss the books your kids are reading with them by asking them to tell you: who their favourite character is and who that reminds them of; how the pictures match the story and what they see about the story in the picture; the top 3 things they learned from the book or what it is about in their own words; what they liked best or would have changed in the story; what subject they'd like to read about or what they'd like to read next; or who their favourite author is and why.
