Greetings Fireside families & friends!

This week saw a return to wintery weather and snow. Despite the cold, lots of learning and activities were going on inside and outside our school. The grade 2's are getting set to begin swimming lessons. Grade 6 has been learning about the Iroquois Democracy, specifically the *Tree of Peace*. Many classes have been looking at important aspects of remembrance ahead of Remembrance Day next week.

On Wednesday, we held our second S.O.A.R. Assembly to recognize students who show exceptional Spirit, Outstanding Character, Achievement, and Respectful, Responsible attitudes in our school. Our Junior A Volleyball teams were at Divisionals on Tuesday and Thursday: both teams won Bronze in the 1A Division! They played well and showcased their growing skills and confidence with pride: way to go

Hawks! And the grade 6 Volleyball Tournament is taking place tonight: watch for results in next week's *Focus*.

At last week's School Council meeting, we investigated parent desire to include their children in "bigger ticket" field trips, such as swimming. We heard that these opportunities are valued, and thus we will continue to explore them. We also discussed parent perspectives on student dress code. The consensus is that there continues to be one area where "policing" is desired: Offensive/vulgar/discriminatory messages on clothing will continue to not be permitted in school. Written policy regarding other aspects of attire was felt to be unnecessary beyond that piece. Lastly, we discussed that a request had been made at the divisional level to provide direction on participating in Healthy Hunger programs. This conversation has been tabled for the time being, and will be taken up before the end of the year. We greatly appreciate the participation of our School Council members and would invite any parents or guardians interested in being part of these discussions to consider attending our next session on Wednesday December 7th. 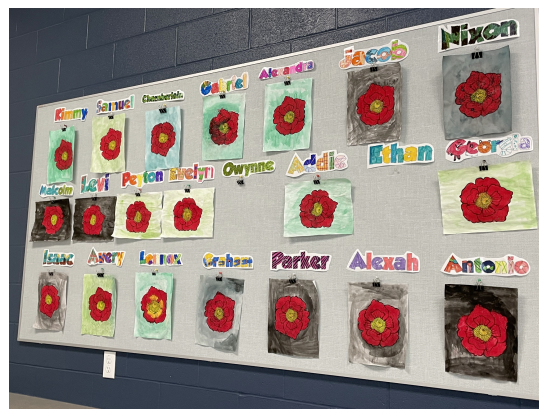

NEW: Remembrance Day Assemblies

Fireside School will be hosting its first in-person Remembrance Day Assemblies in two years on Thursday, November 10. These assemblies will recognize Remembrance Day and will also include acknowledgement of National Indigenous Veterans Day (which is on November 8). The first assembly will be from 8:45 to 9:30 am, for students in even-numbered grades (K, 2, 4, 6 and 8); please arrive between 8:30 and 8:40 am. The second assembly will be from 10:45 to 11:30 am for students in odd-numbered grades (1, 3, 5 and 7); please arrive between 10:30 and 10:40 am.



Our theme this year is “Hopes for Peace”. The program will include music, videos, poem readings, and a choir performance, as well as a moment of silence and laying of a wreath to mark the significance of Remembrance Day. The Grades 3-6 choir, select members of our band program, and student readers have been practicing hard to showcase and honour our veterans and those engaged in military service, those who were and are committed to peace for our world. If you have relatives who served in the military or were involved in any war effort, we invite you to have students bring in the names and/or images by the start of next week (Nov. 7). They can drop it off in the school office or in the box that will be in front of the band room. These names and images will be included in the program during the moment of silence and laying of the wreath.

Our 3-Way Conferences are part of Rocky View Schools' Communication of Student Learning. These 10-minute conferences include parents, teachers, and students and offer a chance to review the student's progress to date and to set goals for the next steps of their learning journey.

Conference Manager will open for bookings on November 7th at 8:00 AM and will close on November 14th at 4:00 PM. Please call the school office (403-932-4868) if you have questions or are having difficulties logging in. When the conference booking site opens, please book an appointment date and time that works for you. When you are booking your appointment time, you will be prompted to provide a phone number where the teacher can reach you, should technical issues arise.

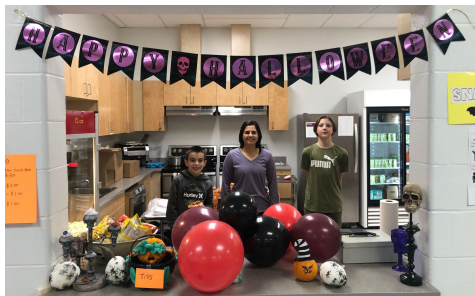

Kids Have Stress Too! (KHST)

Wednesdays November 9 and 23 at Fireside School from 7:00-8:30pm

Come join us for two informative evenings facilitated by our Child Development Advisor and Family Educator, Charlene Abrahams. This FREE program is for parents and caregivers of children Pre-K to Grade 5. The KHST program is a 2-session program, and it is recommended that participants attend both sessions.

The Kids Have Stress Too! program is designed to help parents and caregivers become more aware of children's stress and to help children cope with and develop effective ways of dealing with stress. Participants will be provided examples of activities and strategies that can be used to help children manage day-to-day struggles and stress and ease the transition from home to school.
