




### NEW: Tote-a-Coat on November 16 & 17

On Thursday, Fireside School held its Remembrance Day Ceremonies to recognize Remembrance Day and, also, National Indigenous Veterans Day (November 8). Our theme was "Our Hopes for Peace".

A video was shared from Veterans Canada to highlight Canada's Indigenous Veterans before the traditional poetry and readings.

Following the reading of Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae's poem "In Flanders Field", grade 5 and grade 8 students shared "High Flight" by John Gillespie Magee Jr. and poems from Afghani and Syrian youths that were


written for Unicef's Youth Voices – Poetry for Peace initiative; these young people used poetry to express their hopes for a more peaceful future. A video poem from a young Ukranian girl, who expressed hope for there to be peace in her country, was also shared, as we reflected on our own hopes for peace for the people of Ukraine. Students in Cadets, Scouts, Girl Guides, or Sparks assisted with the presentation of our ceremonial wreaths. Finally, the Grade 3-6 Choir sang "Peace I Leave With You" at the closing of our assembly.

Conference Manager opened for bookings on November 7th at 8:00 AM; it will close on November 14th at 4:00 PM. Please call the school office (403-932-4868) if you have questions or are having difficulties logging in. When the conference booking site opens, please book an appointment date and time that works for you. When you are booking your appointment time, you will be prompted to provide a phone number where the teacher can reach you, should technical issues arise.

If you have never used Conference Manager before, please register first. Returning users should ensure they can log in to the system – a password reset is available if necessary. Please review your parent/guardian profile to ensure the information is correct, especially the email address, as the email address you provide in this profile will be used to send you the booking confirmation.
