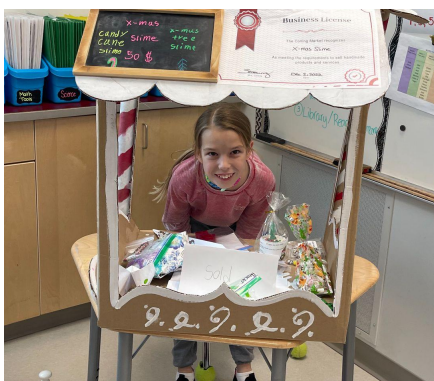

Tuesday, June 27, 2023:	Science

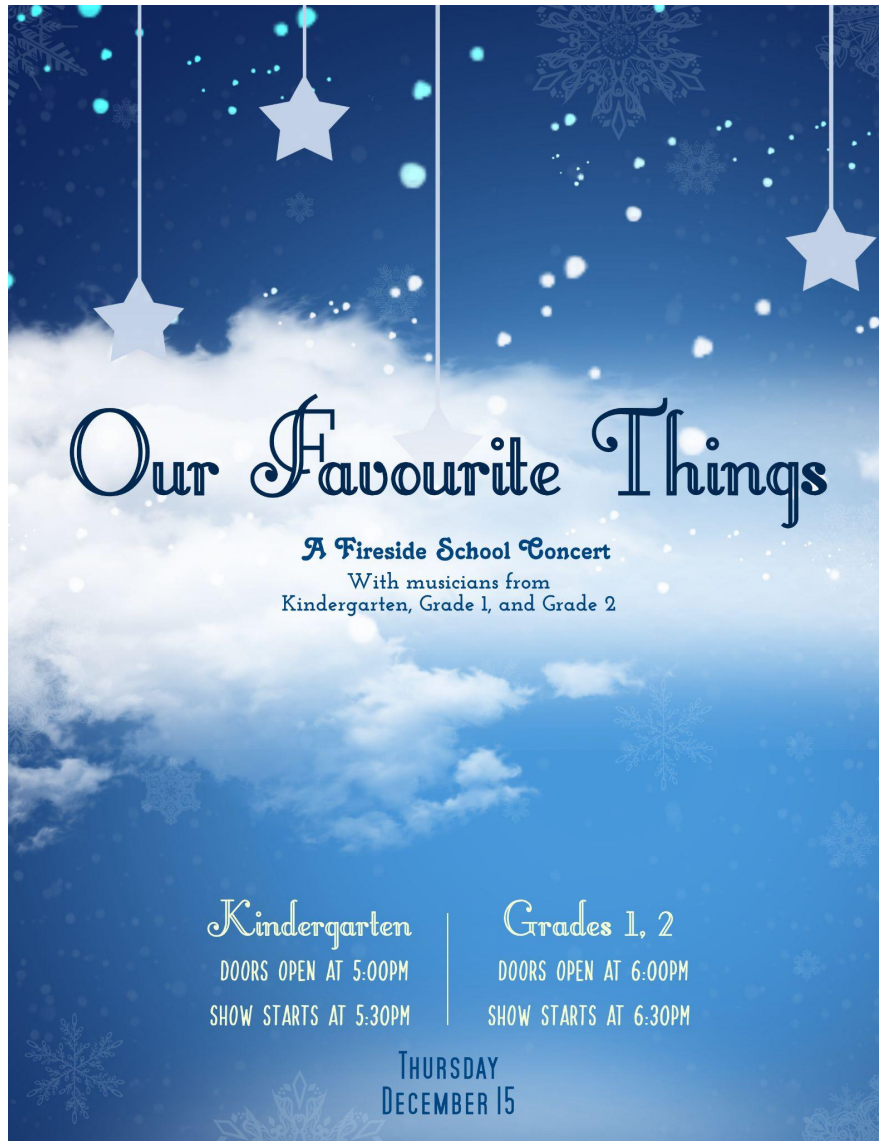
