Greetings Families and Friends of Fireside,
It was a fantastic week at Fireside School, where the highlight was certainly our Read-a-Thon \& SOAR Award assemblies. There was MUCH to celebrate. During Read-a-Thon, we read over 1.2 million minutes as a school and raised more than $\$ 12,000$. At the assembly, prizes and awards were presented to over 95 students! We also handed out dozens of SOAR awards to students who demonstrated incredible Spirit, Outstanding Character, Achievement, and Responsibility. Students are excited for next week, when we'll be rolling out a change to our positive behaviour ticket system in the school.
