NEW: Parent Volunteers

During the school year, there will be opportunities for volunteers to help in our school. To be able to volunteer, some paperwork must be completed and submitted prior to the volunteer activity. First, a police check must be completed. Please see the end of this document for a copy of the Criminal Record/Vulnerable Sector Application (AF490-A). Once filled out, it is taken to the RCMP (359 - 1st St E). The RCMP will process the application and mail you the record check, which you then bring to the school. We will take a copy and keep it on file, where the document will stay valid for 5 years. The check can take up to 3 weeks to complete, so if you anticipate volunteering at any point this year, it may be worth starting the process early. On your first day of volunteering, there will be additional forms to be completed at the school (Confidentiality/ Non-Disclosure, Annual Declaration, & Image Release Forms).

Families looking to volunteer in their teachers' classes are encouraged to reach out directly to teachers to learn more about opportunities. UPDATED: Student Drop Off and Pick Up

Parents who come to either pick up or drop off their children are asked to follow all traffic regulations. The best places to drop off students is on the east side of the school in the "Kiss and Go" or along Fireside Parkway (but not in the bus lanes). For safety reasons, please do not park, drop off, or pick up students in the Fireside School Staff parking lot, with the exception of parents who have arranged to drop off students with mobility issues using the wheelchair-accessible spaces.

Please note that we now have three additional buses transporting students to and from our school. Our bus lanes will not be able to accommodate all the buses. As such, the roadway adjacent to the staff parking lot will house an extra bus, which will typically result in the entrance to the parking lot being blocked for loading and unloading of students. There will also be two buses at the front of the school. Please drive safely.

REMINDER: Appointments

There may be times when you need to pick your child up from school during instructional times. A parent, guardian, or authorized person (which must be noted in PowerSchool) must come into the building to sign child(ren) out; please note that this process may take a few minutes. It is appreciated that you inform the homeroom teacher and the office (fireside@rockyview.ab.ca) of the appointment in advance. Please note that children may sign themselves *in* at the front office without an adult present.
