





Kindergarten 2024-25 Registration and Information Session



Registration for Kindergarten 2024-25 will open on Monday, January 22. Information about Kindergarten registration, registration documents, and what to do after registration can be found on Rocky View Schools site. Children who are five years old on or before December 31, 2024 may register in Kindergarten for the 2024–25 school year.

On Wednesday, February 7, we are pleased to welcome families with children who'll be starting Kindergarten in September 2024 to our Kindergarten Information Session. This evening will run from 5:00 to 6:00 pm here at the school. We'll be sharing information about what to expect in Kindergarten, along with other important information about attending Fireside School. Fireside School's 3rd Annual Read-a-Thon



We are very excited to announce that Fireside School's 3rd Annual Read-a-Thon will begin in two weeks!

It starts on Friday, January 26 (one day before Family Literacy Day) and will run for just over two weeks, ending on Monday, February 12. This year's theme is *Book Love: Growing Readers*. Our FUNdraising this year will go toward adding new Literacy Kits and Book Sets to our school's literacy resources.

During Read-a-Thon, each student sets a personal reading goal. Your child will keep track of their reading on the Master Tracker Form that will come home; they will keep track of "At School" reading and "On Own/At Home" reading. They can also collect pledges from family, neighbours, and others for the FUNdraiser on the Pledge Form (on the back of the Master Tracker Form).

One new aspect this year includes students and their parents submitting each "week's" minutes through an online Google Form. Here are the time-frames for each week of Read-a-Thon:

Week 1: Jan 26 to Feb 2

Week 2: Feb 3 to Feb 9

Week 3: Feb 10 to Feb 12

The reading information to be submitted will be clearly marked on the Master Tracker Form and instructions will be included on the top of the Google Form.

Watch for more information and updates next week in *Focus* and via email the week it begins. 2024 Read-a-Thon packages will come home on Thursday, January 25. So, get ready to read read for Read-a-Thon!



**Updated: School Bus Reminders** 



If your child rides a school bus, please take a few moments to review the information and rules below.

With the very cold weather, please help your children remember to bring appropriate winter wear for their time at the bus stop and riding on the bus.

On extremely cold days such as the ones we had this week, students who are in the second-run of bus departures, now wait inside the school until the first-run of buses departs and their buses then arrive. Those who take the BGC bus wait near the front door; those who take Buses 26, 195, and 227 wait inside the grade 4/7 doors that exit out to the bus lane.

Some important safety reminders for riding the school bus:

- wait back from the edge of the sidewalk (e.g. on the grass) until the bus stops
- always listen to the bus driver and instructions they are giving at any time.
- use handrails getting on and off the bus and secure items such as backpacks.
- sit down in the assigned seat as quickly as possible (riders must follow the seating plan).
- stay seated (e.g. back to the back of the seat) and face forward.
- not walk around or switch seats inside the bus while it's moving.
- keep the aisles clear.
- keep their head, hands, and arms inside the bus (not out the windows).
- wait until the bus comes to a full stop **before** they stand up to exit.
- talk quietly; do not shout or scream on the bus so the driver can concentrate.
- be courteous and kind to other people riding the bus.
- use appropriate language at all times.
- report any incidents or concerns to the driver.

<u>The Alberta Government</u> provides additional information for Albertans on school bus safety, including information on going to the bus stop and pedestrian safety rules, waiting at the bus stop, and getting on the school bus.

Rocky View Schools also has a video about riding the school bus for students and families.
