

Hello Fireside Families & Friends,

There was plenty of interesting and engaging learning this week. Classes are digging into science experiments, working on numeracy routines, immersing themselves in new stories, and learning about the world around them. There are early-year numeracy and literacy assessments taking place, which are used to guide our instruction as we move forward in the year. These assessments are not counted in student's grades and are only used to help us determine where students are at in their learning progressions as we start the year.

Next week we'll be honouring National Day for Truth and Reconciliation with our Orange Shirt Day on the Thursday prior. Updated: Allergy Awareness and Scent-Free Policy

At Fireside School, we want to do our best to keep everyone safe and healthy. We have a number of students and staff who are highly sensitive to certain allergens.
