Fireside School's Read-a-Thon came to an end last Sunday, and reading minute totals continued to come in over the course of the week. Currently, we are sitting at almost 783,000 minutes for the month! AMAZING!! Minute totals will continue to be totaled into early next week to ensure that all forms have been returned.

Now that the minutes submission deadline has arrived, we will be calculating totals and awarding the Scholastic Gift Card Prizes (to be used at our Book Fair in April) to the top reader of each grade. The draws for students who read 500 and 1000 minutes will be made on Monday, March 7. These prizes are kindly sponsored by The Friends of Fireside Society. We truly appreciate their generous support of our students and programs at Fireside School.

Now that students have collected pledges, it is time to submit those funds to the school. Please note that Fireside School does not accept cash. Thank you to those of you who have already submitted your donations.

There are 2 ways to submit funds for our Read-a-Thon:

1. Log into your *School Cash Online* account, then choose the "Make A Donation" bar.

*Enter your donation amount and choose **Fireside School** from the Fund Destination drop-down.

*In the Message box, **enter 'Read-A-Thon: [Student's Name]'**.

*A receipt will be emailed to you.

*If there are sponsors who are still interested in making a one-time donation, please have them do so before Monday, March 7, 2022.

2. Wait for the pledged amount to be added to your child's *School Cash Online* account.
(Please note: Amounts for payment should appear starting Tuesday, March 8, 2022, depending on form submission.)

*Based on the student's submitted Read-A-Thon sponsor log, a catalogue item will be created for you to purchase that reflects your child's total pledges.

*A receipt will be emailed to you.

When the conference booking site opens, please book an appointment date and time that works for you. When you are booking your appointment time, you will be prompted to provide a phone number where the teacher can reach you, should technical issues arise.

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
