Reminder: Outstanding School Fees

School Fee Invoices were sent out this week for fees that are outstanding and overdue. Reminder: Grade 7 & 8 Option Course Fee Waiver

Families can have their Grade 7/8 Option Course Fees waived under certain circumstances. Upon receipt by the school principal of [Form AF5105 Waiver Application](#), parents/guardians of students who provide a copy of their Goods and Services Tax (GST) credit notice with the names of dependent children listed, will qualify to have their Grade 7/8 Optional Course Fees waived. The deadline for submission of Form AF5105 Waiver Application to the school principal is June 30th of the current school year.

REMINDER: Friday Bus Delays – Road Construction

The Town of Cochrane has advised us that road construction at the bottom of the 4th Avenue hill will restrict traffic flow in that part of Cochrane. This will have an impact on buses leaving the Cochrane tri-schools area whose routes on Friday are completed before ours. Please expect there may be afternoon bus delays on Fridays throughout May and June. Bus supervisors *will* remain outside with students until they are picked up at the school, but delays may be significant.
