NEW: Healthy Hunger - Friday, January 14

Our next date for Healthy Hunger is this coming Friday, January 14, 2022. The provider is The Brewhouse in Cochrane; offerings include pasta, pizza, and chicken fingers, among other items.

Please note that orders need to be in by Sunday, January 9. If you've already placed an order and need to cancel it, that is also the deadline for cancellation.

NEW: Bus Lane Safety

As we return to school, just a friendly reminder to parents and families to leave the bus lanes on the north side of the school open for School Buses only. Especially with our snowy and icy conditions at this time, having other vehicles in this space presents a number of safety concerns for students, families, and vehicles. Thank you for your cooperation with and attention to this reminder.

NEW: RVS Updates to Return to School Operations

For your reference, Rocky View Schools' most up-to-date <u>2021-2022 Return to School Operations</u> <u>Plan</u> has been posted to the Rocky View Schools site.

NEW: Daily Health Checklist Usage

RVS will continue to require all students, staff, and visitors to use the most updated <u>Alberta Daily Health Checklist</u> (click on the link to view) on the Alberta Government site prior to coming to school each day. Parents/Guardians play an essential role, as they support actions in the home (such as keeping children/students home when sick and accessing testing if symptoms develop) that ultimately keep other children, students, and staff safe.

NEW: Masking Reminders

A few friendly reminders about Masking as we come back to school on January 10, 2022.

As per the provincial requirements, masks continue to be required for all individuals (students, drivers, volunteers, and staff) on a school bus. Masks will not be required outdoors at RVS schools and sites.

A non-medical face mask is required while inside RVS schools and sites for:

- All students (Pre-Kindergarten Grade 12)
- All staff members
- All visitors/volunteers

A reminder that Mask Exceptions can only be granted by a nurse practitioner, physician, or a psychologist using the provincial <u>Medical Note for Mask Exception</u> form.

UPDATED: If Students Arrive to School Late for Any Reason...

If students arrive late for school in the morning (after the start Period 1, which begins at 8:05 am) or after the start of Period 5 (12:15 pm) in the afternoon, they need to sign in at the office, please. Please note that if they arrive after 8:15 am in the morning, they will need to enter through the front doors; the same is true for after lunch, if they arrive after 12:20 pm.

UPDATED: Community Volunteering to Return in the New Year

Fireside School is thrilled to announce that parent and community volunteering will be making a comeback in 2022. Hopefully everyone received the link to an online form, which was sent out for prospective volunteers to be able to indicate their availability and preferred activities prior to the break.

Please note that volunteers will be required to have completed a vulnerable sector check and to show proof of double vaccination. Volunteers will also need to wear a mask during their time in the school building. We're looking forward to seeing adults back in our school and engaging in a variety of supportive activities. Please note this request does not replace those being made by individual teachers for support, which will likely be forthcoming in the next few weeks as well. Families are encouraged to continue responding to those requests with your very appreciated support.

UPDATED: Grade 6 Provincial Achievement Tests (PATs at Fireside

Grade 6 students at Fireside School will be writing Provincial Achievement Tests in May and June 2022 for this school year. In the coming months, Grade 6 teachers will continue their work with students around how best to engage and prepare for these assessments, including engagement of practice PAT assessments and reviews of assessment-taking strategies and skills.

For your reference, here are the dates for schools for Fireside students:

- Wednesday, May 18, 2022: Grade 6 English Language Arts Part A (Written)
- Wednesday, June 15, 2022: Grade 6 English Language Arts Part B (Reading Comprehension)
- Friday, June 17, 2022: Grade 6 Mathematics Part A (Numerical Response)
- Monday, June 20, 2022: Grade 6 Mathematics Part B (Multiple-Choice)

- Wednesday, June 22, 2022: Grade 6 Science
- Thursday, June 23, 2022: Grade 6 Social Studies

Reminder: Fireside School Nutrition Program

Fireside's School Nutrition Program has had some changes that we wish to bring to your attention. However, what is still the same is that food is available for students who've forgotten their lunch or snacks or for those who need school to supply a lunch (no questions asked).


